

## Skip Stitch instructions

Replace the regular blade in your rotary cutter with the skip stitch blade. First, even off your fleece so the edges are straight and you line up the fleece edge with your quilting ruler. I go about  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch into the fleece. Run the rotary cutter against the ruler until you reach the end of the ruler or the cutting mat. Reposition the fleece and ruler and continue.

The holes are about  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches apart, you will want to remember this when repositioning from the last hole you cut.



Once the holes are made you are ready to crochet an edge around the blanket. Check our previous news letter or our web site for Jane's favorite edges if you would like some ideas.
